The Portokalos family gather for a poignant family reunion in a quaint Greek village to honour the cherished final wish of the dearly departed family patriarch, Gus Portokalos.


Following the death of Gus, Toula honors his last wish by visiting his childhood village to "reconnect" with their "roots".


