External Assessment Trials for Mathematics B and HPE June 2017

The new Senior Assessment and Tertiary Entrance System begins in all Queensland schools in 2019. A feature of the new system is the introduction of external assessment for most subjects.

To support the introduction of external assessment, QCAA is conducting trials in a range of subjects. Our school will be involved in the external assessment trials for <u>Mathematics B and Health and Physical Education</u>. This will give us the opportunity to become familiar with the use of subject-based external assessments, and enable the QCAA to evaluate the effectiveness of its processes.

The trial assessments are aligned to the existing syllabus and designed as an alternative to a task already being undertaken in these subjects. The exams will be administered under secure conditions and corrected by external markers.

Teachers will inform students on what materials are required and ensure they are well prepared for this assessment.
