How to apply?

In just seven steps, you can become a USQ Head Start student.

- Find an area of study that interests you and ensure that the additional workload of the USQ course can be accommodated into your school study schedule.
- 2 Choose a course offered under the USQ Head Start program. They are listed at usq.edu.au/headstart
- 3 Complete the USQ Head Start Application Form, including all supporting documents. Don't forget that your application needs to be signed by your school principal and parent or caregiver and, of course, yourself. You can find the USQ Head Start application form at **usq.edu.au/headstart**
- **4** Send your application to **study@usq.edu.au** by 5:00pm of the closing date.
- **5** USQ will assess your application.
- 6 You and your school will be notified whether your application has been successful. This will be approximately two weeks before semester begins. If you are accepted to study a USQ Head Start course, you will receive a letter with your USQ username and password which you will need for your studies.
- 7 To help you get off to a flying start with your uni studies, there is a USQ Head Start Orientation Program for all Head Start students one week before the start of semesters 1 and 2.
