## Release of 2019 QCS Test grades, Year 12 results, OPs and FPs

### Purpose

To inform schools about the release of 2019 Queensland Core Skills (QCS) Test student grades and Year 12 results, OPs and FPs.

### Information

#### Release of QCS Test grades

Students' individual QCS Test grades will be released prior to senior certification in December.

From 9 am on Wednesday 13 November 2019:

- students will be able to access their individual QCS Test grade — from A to E — in their learning account on the Student Connect website: <https://studentconnect.qcaa.qld.edu.au>
- schools will be able to access their students' QCS Test grades in a report on the QCAA secure website ([www.qcaa.qld.edu.au/secure\\_site/Login.do](http://www.qcaa.qld.edu.au/secure_site/Login.do)) and in QCAA Portal ([www.qcaa.qld.edu.au/portal](http://www.qcaa.qld.edu.au/portal)). Scaling parameters are still being determined and will not be released at this time.

Students' QCS Test grades will be confirmed on the Senior Statement they receive as part of their Senior Education Profile sent to them in December.

#### Release of Year 12 results, OPs and FPs

From 9 am on Saturday 14 December, all results contributing to the Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE), OPs and FPs will be available in student learning accounts on the Student Connect website: <https://studentconnect.qcaa.qld.edu.au>

From Monday 16 December, students will begin receiving their Senior Education Profiles in the mail. Depending on students' individual circumstances, their profile will comprise one or more of the following documents:

- QCE
- Tertiary Entrance Statement
- Senior Statement
- Queensland Certificate of Individual Achievement.

## Student Connect website

Students must know their Learner Unique Identifier (LUI) and password to log in and check their results online. Students will gain faster access to their results if they have previously activated their learning account. Schools are reminded that it is their responsibility to ensure students have been issued with their LUI.

## What you need to do

- Make all senior school teachers and guidance officers aware of the arrangements for the release of:
  - individual QCS Test grades on the Student Connect website, QCAA secure site and QCAA Portal from 9 am on Wednesday 13 November
  - Year 12 results, OPs and FPs on the Student Connect website from 9 am on Saturday 14 December.
- Inform students who sat the QCS Test that their test grade will be available in their learning account from 9 am Wednesday 13 November.
- Remind all students in Year 12 of their LUIs. Ask them to log in to their learning accounts and change their email addresses to a non-school account and check that their home address is correct.
- Remind students to check their subject achievement indicators (SAIs) when they are published at the school. The final date for SAIs to be available to students is Wednesday 20 November. This check may eliminate errors in SAIs not picked up by the school, such as OP-eligibility, students being mixed up with others with the same name, and unusual gaps between students that do not reflect their positions on the Form R6.
