2022 Year 9 - Elective Subject Information Form

Next year, students will undertake **two (2)** elective subjects of their choice in years 9 and 10. To allow for lines to be created based on student preference in this cohort, students will **select two (2) elective subjects and one (1) reserve subject from the list below in order of preference.** All students complete their elective subjects in addition to their six core subjects. **Elective subject choices are due Friday 5 November online.**

What do we need to do?

3. Complete the online 'Year 9 Subject Selection Form' by following the steps detailed in the email sent to students on Monday 1 November & explained in the presentation on our website as above.
 - **NOTE:** Students select two (2) elective subjects in order of preferences + one (1) reserve subject.

4. Students will receive a final subject selection form which will confirm subject selections for 2022.

Note the following:

- Subjects do have maximum numbers and if required, will be created based on the order of online forms submitted as they are time stamped.
- "Lines" will be developed based on student subject selection. Factors such as staffing constraints, facilities available and student demand will be important in determining lines. Subjects may not proceed if too few students select a subject. Some students may need to re-consider subject choices after lines have been developed.
- If students require their reserve subject to be used or if further consultation is required for subject selection, the Deputy Principal will discuss this with the student/parent.
